SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION:

Branstad State Fair Scholarship-Seniors who actively participate in the Iowa State Fair & who plan to enroll in an Iowa college or university are eligible for a \$1000 scholarship. For more info & an app (due May 1), visit:
