Standard A1

Joint Construction

- Excellent 90-100% Joints must be constructed properly and show no gaps. They should be free of excess glue with only a clean line where parts are joined together. Proper joint for the application should be used.
- Good 70-80% Joints have some gaps, and excess glue. Proper joint for the application.
- Poor 50-60% Joint has gaps with excessive glue showing. Improper joint for the application.

Standard A1,D1

Workmanship

- Excellent 90-100% The overall workmanship of the project should be as close to professional quality as possible. This means pieces are cut properly, put together properly, built according to plans, and is generally an excellent job done.
- Good 70-80% Parts are cut to within 1/32" and assembled but some problems exist, either visually or structurally. Plans were mostly followed.

- Poor 50-60% Cuts are 1/16" or greater off. Parts are assembled but many problems exist both visually and structurally. Plans were not followed.

Standard A1,C1

Sanding and Finishing

- Excellent 90-100% This must be done with great care so as to achieve a smooth finish with no runs no drips and no errors. Scratches across the grain and saw marks should be removed. Stains should not be blotchy but evenly coated for a natural look to the product.
- Good 70-80% Sanding will show some signs of scratches and saw marks. Stain has some uneven qualities and clear finish has no more than two drips or thick spots. A difference in finish sheen exists due to uneven coating or sanding of the finish.
- Poor 50-60% Obvious scratches or saw marks exist. Runs, drips, and thick portions of finish exist. Stain has uneven coverage and places with no stain or finish exist.

Standard C1

Timely Manor

- Excellent 90-100% The student should discuss with the teacher and come to an agreement as to the time duration the project should take. The student should work to finish the project by that designated time.
- Good 70-80% Took 10-20% longer than the project was supposed to.
- Poor 50-60% Took 30% or longer than the project was supposed to.
