

Selective Service registration:

Virtually every man living in America and U.S. citizen abroad is required to register with Selective Service within 30 days of his 18th birthday. It's his legal and civic responsibility. In fact, it's the law!

Once a young man registers, he stays eligible for programs and benefits connected to registration, such as college loans and grants, government jobs, job training, and citizenship for immigrant men seeking to become U.S. citizens.

When you register via the internet, you will receive your Selective Service registration number immediately. That number is your proof of registration – for safekeeping, jot it down. You will receive a Selective Service card by mail within 2 weeks confirming that number. (Note: If you registered by mail, you will receive a card confirming your registration within 60 – 90 days.) If you don't get a your card within 90 days, write to:
